Federal Carbon Charge

As part of the federal government's **carbon reduction plan**, a new carbon charge applies to all fossil fuels sold in Ontario. This includes natural gas. It is effective **April 1st, 2019**. The federal carbon charge for natural gas will be 3.91 cents per cubic meter increasing annually each April. All the money that we collect for the **federal carbon charge** goes to the federal government.



How does this impact you?

It is forecasted that for the average Six Nations Natural Gas residential customer, this will add about **\$89 to your annual natural gas bill**. Customers of Six Nations Natural Gas will see this monthly cost on their monthly bills as a separate line item beginning with the **April 2019 invoice**.

The federal government has indicated **Ontario residents will receive a tax-free climate action incentive payment after filing their 2018 tax return**. This amount will more than cover the cost of the carbon charge for 2019.
